Position Title: Associate Worship Pastor
Reports To: Lead Worship Pastor

Status: Full-time, Exempt

Position Summary: The Worship Leader is responsible for moving a large, multi-site, worship ministry forward in a thriving (10,000+) church. The Associate Worship Pastor will facilitate and develop the mission and vision of the church through Central Music and the Central Music teams.

This position is connected to the faith and ministry of the church and moves forward the vision of Central Christian Church.

Responsibilities:

- Support vision and direction of the Lead Worship Pastor.
- Support vision and direction of Central Christian Church and Creative Arts Team leadership.
- Lead worship onstage at least 3 times per month.
- Contribute to the worship set planning and execution for the weekend services.
- Help oversee the scheduling and development of worship services at all campuses.
- Help oversee the development of all worship leaders, vocal team members, and musicians.
- Other duties as assigned by supervisor.

Knowledge, Skills and Experience Required:

- Experience in a large church preferred. Must be able to communicate with and inspire a sizeable team of creative individuals.
- Excellent written and communication skills.
- Organizational skills.
- Ability to work independently within scope of assignment. Manages time and prioritizes duties effectively.
- Ability to work cooperatively as a member of a team.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office programs.
- Proficiency in PCO.
