Read Genesis 39:7-23. How does this part of Joseph's story challenge your sense of fairness?

What can this story teach us about God? What can it teach us about ourselves?

WHAT IS MY INITIAL REACTION?

How do you tend to respond when things do not go your way?

Read Jeremiah 1:4-8. How can you relate to Jeremiah in this passage?

What fears and excuses are currently keeping you from leading where you are?

How does verse 5 address the way you view your fears?

WHAT AM I GOING TO DO?

What unique people and situations do you have in your life that only you are capable of influencing?

How can short sightedness keep us from accomplishing the great things God has planned for us?

Read Exodus 1:1-8. What does this text say about the legacy of Joseph? What do you want your legacy to be?

How will you start leading now so that you can have a generational influence?
