SERIES & TITLE	<i>Book of Hebrews: Something Better - Week 9 - HOPE</i>
 BIG IDEA	Hope in Jesus is not wishful thinking. It is confidence a living God has something better for you.
 ICE BREAKER	What was the last thing you wished for or wished would happen?
 DISCUSS	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. How do Christians sometimes view Jesus as Santa Claus?2. What is the difference between wishing and hoping?3. Is there an area in your life where you currently feel hopeless? What do you think God wants you to know about that area or situation? (See Scripture below)4. What does it look like to practice confident hope?
 FOR STUDENTS	Pastor Eric talked about how we all struggle with confidence. In what ways or areas do you struggle with confidence?
 CHALLENGE	Spend some time every day this week reading Hebrews. Pray before you read, asking God to open your heart to hear what He has to say to you. After reading the scripture, spend 10-15 minutes seeking to hear from God. Write down what you feel God is speaking to you.
 SCRIPTURE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Hebrews 7:17- 19 For it is declared: “You are a priest forever, in the order of Melchizedek.” The former regulation is set aside because it was weak and useless 19 (for the law made nothing perfect), and a better hope is introduced, by which we draw near to God.● Hebrews 10:22-24 Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold unwaveringly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds.
 PRAYER	Ask God to give you confident hope in Him - especially in the areas where you are currently experiencing hopelessness.
