 <b>SERIES &amp; TITLE</b>	The Chosen
 <b>BIG IDEA</b>	Just as these children chose you... God chose you!
 <b>ICE BREAKER</b>	Did you participate in the Chosen? If so who chose you? Tell the group about them!
 <b>MAIN POINTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Through the Chosen Program Central families were able to sponsor over 1300 kids!</li><li>● Jesus cares deeply for children. He was indignant when the disciples tried to prevent children from coming to him.</li><li>● We are all chosen by God.</li></ul>
 <b>DISCUSS</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. What most stood out to you from the message this weekend?</li><li>2. The kingdom of God belongs to those with childlike innocence, hope and faith. How can we recapture more of that attitude?</li><li>3. How might sponsoring a child affect our own faith and perspective?</li><li>4. Just as the children were thrilled to be chosen, God delights in choosing us. How does being wanted and loved by God change how we see ourselves?</li></ol>
 <b>CHALLENGE</b>	Sponsor a child through World Vision's Chosen Program!
 <b>SCRIPTURE</b>	Mark 10:13-16 People were bringing little children to Jesus for him to place his hands on them, but the disciples rebuked them. When Jesus saw this, he was indignant. He said to them, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Truly I tell you, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it." And he took the children in his arms, placed his hands on them and blessed them.
