| BIG IDEA                                | Empathy, without action, is mere apathy.   |

| MAIN POINTS                             | <ul> <li>Karenism (angry, entitled outbursts) seems increasingly common in our culture. This may reflect that society is losing emotional balance and empathy.</li> <li>Empathy is the ability to understand and share the feelings of another. It fuels compassion. Jesus demonstrated perfect empathy for us.</li> <li>Jesus calls his followers to develop empathy. The parable of the sheep and goats shows we'll be held accountable for how we treat others.</li> <li>Serving the poor and needy is like directly serving Jesus. Lack of empathy leads to inaction.</li> </ul>                   |

What are some key traits of an empathetic person?</li> <li>Why do you think society is currently experiencing an "Empathy Deficit Disorder"? What holds us back sometimes?</li> <li>Pastor Cal challenged us to "experience someone else's reality" this week.
