SERIES & TITLE	<i>Book of Hebrews: Something Better - Week 10</i>
 BIG IDEA	What you focus on determines the path you travel. The path you travel determines your destination.
 ICE BREAKER	When was the last time you got lost while traveling? How'd you get lost and what happened?
 DISCUSS	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Pastor Cal shared two temptations that Israel had in following God: the Temptation to look back and the Temptation to turn back. What's the difference between the two and have you experienced these temptations in your life? How so?2. Pastor Cal shared a few things that most often distracts us from our relationship with God like politics, the economy, the media, our families, our selves etc. What most distracts you from the journey of following Jesus?3. Up to this point in your life how would you describe your journey of following Jesus?
 FOR STUDENTS	Are there people you know and respect that live lives that are focused on Jesus? Who are they and what shows you that they are focused on Jesus?
 CHALLENGE	Pastor Cal shared 6 ways to stay focused on Jesus: Be in the Word daily, Worship regularly, Pray consistently, Serve generously, Live in Christian community, Be sensitive to the Spirit always. Which can you be more intentional about this week?
 SCRIPTURE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Luke 9:62 Jesus replied, “No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God.”● Hebrews 11:13-16 All these people were still living by faith when they died. They did not receive the things promised; they only saw them and welcomed them from a distance, admitting that they were foreigners and strangers on earth. People who say such things show that they are looking for a country of their own. If they had been thinking of the country they had left, they would have had opportunity to return. Instead, they were longing for a better country—a heavenly one. Therefore, God is not ashamed to be called their God, for he has prepared a city for them.
	Ask God to give you the courage and strength to keep your eyes fixed on Jesus!
