 BIG IDEA	Jesus paid for our admission into God’s presence.

 FOR STUDENTS	Why do you think super heros are so popular in our culture today?
 CHALLENGE	Spend some time every day this week reading Hebrews. Pray before you read, asking God to open your heart to hear what He has to say to you. After reading the scripture, spend 10-15 minutes seeking to hear from God. Write down what you feel God is speaking to you.
 SCRIPTURE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Hebrews 4:14-16 Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. Let us then approach God’s throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.● 1 John 2:1-2 My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have an advocate with the Father—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.
 PRAYER	Thank God for providing an advocate and mediator through Jesus.
