<b>SERIES &amp; TITLE</b>	<i>Book of Hebrews: Something Better - Week 6</i>
 <b>BIG IDEA</b>	Jesus' desire is not just to get you to heaven but heaven into you.
 <b>ICE BREAKER</b>	Did you learn to swim growing up? What were your thoughts about the deep end? What were you told about the "deep end"?
 <b>DISCUSS</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. What most stood out to you from the message this weekend?</li><li>2. For Christians what do you think is the difference between drinking milk and eating solid food? (see Hebrews 5:12-14 below)</li><li>3. What is included in a good spiritual diet?</li><li>4. Pastor Jon shared an "oh-no" passage - a difficult verse to digest and process from Hebrews 6:4-6 (see Scripture below). Do you struggle with these verses? What do you think it means?  <b>CHALLENGE</b>	Spend some time every day this week reading Hebrews. Pray before you read, asking God to open your heart to hear what He has to say to you. After reading the scripture, spend 10-15 minutes seeking to hear from God. Write down what you feel God is speaking to you.
 <b>SCRIPTURE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Hebrews 5:12-14 In fact, though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk, not solid food! 13 Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. 14 But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.</li><li>● Hebrews 6:4-6 For it is impossible to bring back to repentance those who were once enlightened—those who have experienced the good things of heaven and shared in the Holy Spirit, who have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the power of the age to come— and who then turn away from God. It is impossible to bring such people back to repentance; by rejecting the Son of God, they themselves are nailing Him to the cross once again and holding him up to public shame.</li></ul>
