Position Summary: The Campus Operations Manager is responsible for the facility and grounds management and holds in high value to rightly position the entire campus experience to be extraordinary and engaging for everyone who steps on the property. This position is responsible for ministry support, weekend service needs and requirements and able to, at times, accomplish this through the leading all staff, volunteers and contract maintenance. This position, in partnership with the Campus Pastor, will manage the vision for projects and renovations that expand ministry capabilities on a campus.

This position is connected to the faith and ministry of the church and moves forward the mission and vision of Central Christian Church.

Responsibilities:

- Campus operations for safety, beautification and maintenance of all buildings and grounds
- Develop and maintain a schedule of infrastructure needs for routine maintenance and care that ensures ministry support
- > Provide supervision, leadership and discipleship to other Campus Operations staff members
- > Develop and lead a team of volunteers to support all aspects of campus operations
- Manage budget with careful oversight and planning to ensure all goals are met throughout the year
- Oversee scheduling of room set up and tear downs to support ministry needs
- Manage construction projects to a successful completion—meeting schedule and budget parameters
- > Partner with staff to develop priorities for an excellent campus experience
- Other duties as assigned

Knowledge, Skills and Experience Required:

- > Degree in engineering or construction management is desirable but not required
- > 5+ years' experience in leading and executing maintenance activities in an industrial or commercial setting
- > Ability to lead teams to accomplish campus maintenance tasks
- > High level of interpersonal communication and administration skills needed
- Able to work independently as well as contribute to team success
